

**TOWN OF PRESTON  
NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
Thursday, December 7, 2023**

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Town of Preston and those qualified taxpayers lawfully entitled to vote in Preston Town Meetings pursuant to Section 7-6 of the Connecticut General Statutes that a Special Town Meeting will be held on **December 7, 2023 at 7:00 PM, at the Preston Plains Middle School, in the Cafeteria**, 1 Route 164, Preston, Connecticut, for the following purposes:

1. "Shall the Town of Preston adopt a Special Revenue Ordinance for EMS as recommended by the Board of Selectmen?"

2. A. "Shall the Town of Preston, as recommended by the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance, approve the proposal of repurposing the Board of Selectmen's prior years unexpended bonds and earned interest of \$377,318 to be used with the ability to adjust funds up to 10% for the following items not to exceed the total amount?" The items are:

(1) Fire Department Compressors .....	\$110,000
(2) Public Works Roller.....	25,000
(3) Transfer Station Septic.....	38,500
(4) Parks & Recreation Guardrails .....	30,000
(5) Senior Center Van.....	72,000
(6) Senior Center Parking Lot .....	32,000
(7) Town Hall Generator .....	55,000
(8) Contingency .....	<u>14,818</u>
(9) TOTAL .....	<b>\$377,318</b>

B. "Shall the Town of Preston, as recommended by the Board of Education and Board of Finance, approve the proposal of repurposing the Board of Education bond adjustment projects including the 2013 and 2018 remaining amounts in the amount of \$643,932 with the ability to adjust funds up to 10% and not to exceed the total amount for the following items?"

(1) 2013 Remaining .....	\$118,600
(2) 2018 Remaining .....	<u>525,332</u>
(3) TOTAL .....	<b>\$643,932</b>
(4) Telephone System Replacements .....	\$225,000
(5) Cyber Security/Technology Infrastructure .....	120,000
(6) District Camera System .....	150,000
(7) PPMS Elevator.....	<u>148,932</u>
(8) TOTAL .....	<b>\$643,932</b>




3. "Shall the Town of Preston increase the salaries for the Town Clerk/Tax Collector and First Selectperson as recommended by the Board of Finance with a supplemental appropriation?"
  - A. To increase the Town Clerk/Tax Collector's salary by \$383
  - B. To increase the First Selectperson's salary by 10%, which is \$8,706
  
4. "Shall the Town of Preston approve the Board of Selectmen's recommended reappointment to the Preston Redevelopment Agency per the adoption of an Ordinance Establishing a Redevelopment Agency, which was adopted at a Special Town Meeting held on April 30, 2009 and subsequently effective on May 17, 2009. Said Ordinance was amended at a Special Town Meeting held on October 10, 2019 to reduce the number of PRA members from ten (10) to five (5); which was subsequently effective on October 25, 2019?"
  - A. Reappointment of Francis Ennis through October 26, 2028.
  
5. "Shall the Town of Preston discontinue the portion of Fort Point Road shown and designated as that certain piece or parcel of land located in the Town of Preston, County of new London and State of Connecticut, and being shown as 'PORTION OF FORT POINT ROAD TO BE DISCONTINUED' on a certain map or plan entitled: "PLAN PREPARED FOR TOWN OF PRESTON CONN. RTE. 12 AKA MILITARY HIGHWAY PRESTON, CONN. DISCONTINUANCE OF A PORTION OF FORT POINT ROAD SCALE: 1"=80' DESIGN: RJM PROJECT: 15-100 DATE: 1-12-2017 REVISED TO 6/16/23 SHEET NO., 1 OF 1" prepared by Meehan & Goodin Engineers – Surveyors, P.C., 387 North Main Street, Manchester, CT 06042?"


